Re: South Cobb Drive Corridor Development Study – Summary of Public Outreach Session, Smyrna Fall Jonquil Festival

An information kiosk was provided at the City of Smyrna’s Fall Jonquil Festival, on Saturday, October 22, 2016. The kiosk was staffed and receptive to visitors from 9:00am until the festival closed for the day at 6:00pm. The PIOH was the fourth of four planned Public Outreach Sessions for the South Cobb Drive Corridor Development Study. The primary purpose of the information kiosk was to afford the public with an opportunity to ask questions and to provide input during the early stages of the Corridor Development Study. The kiosk was shared with another group who is doing a different corridor development study on the Spring Road Corridor for the City of Smyrna.

The kiosk included a display of the existing conditions along the project corridor, including the improvements at Glendale Place currently under construction, and the future pedestrian crossing just west of Plaza Drive programmed by the Georgia Department of Transportation. A display of the future pedestrian crossing and a display showing the existing, as well as some proposed, typical cross sections were also provided.

Handout packages that included an introduction page and a Public Outreach Comment Form were given to interested parties (see Attachment 1 – Handout Packages). The package provided several options to provide feedback for the corridor study and requested all comments by November 1, 2016 which is the end of the public comment period for the corridor study. The handout packages were also available in Spanish.

We received approximately ninety-eight (98) visitors at the kiosk and twenty (20) Public Outreach Comment Forms were received at the session (see Attachment 2 – Public Comment Outreach Forms Received at Fall Jonquil Festival). The general sentiment from the public during discussions at the kiosk was that of interest and support.

The public comment period ends on November 1, 2016. At that time, all comments received during the public comment period will be compiled and a complete Summary of Comments will be prepared. Also, at that time, replies will be provided to all commenters who provided a mailing or e-mailing address.
